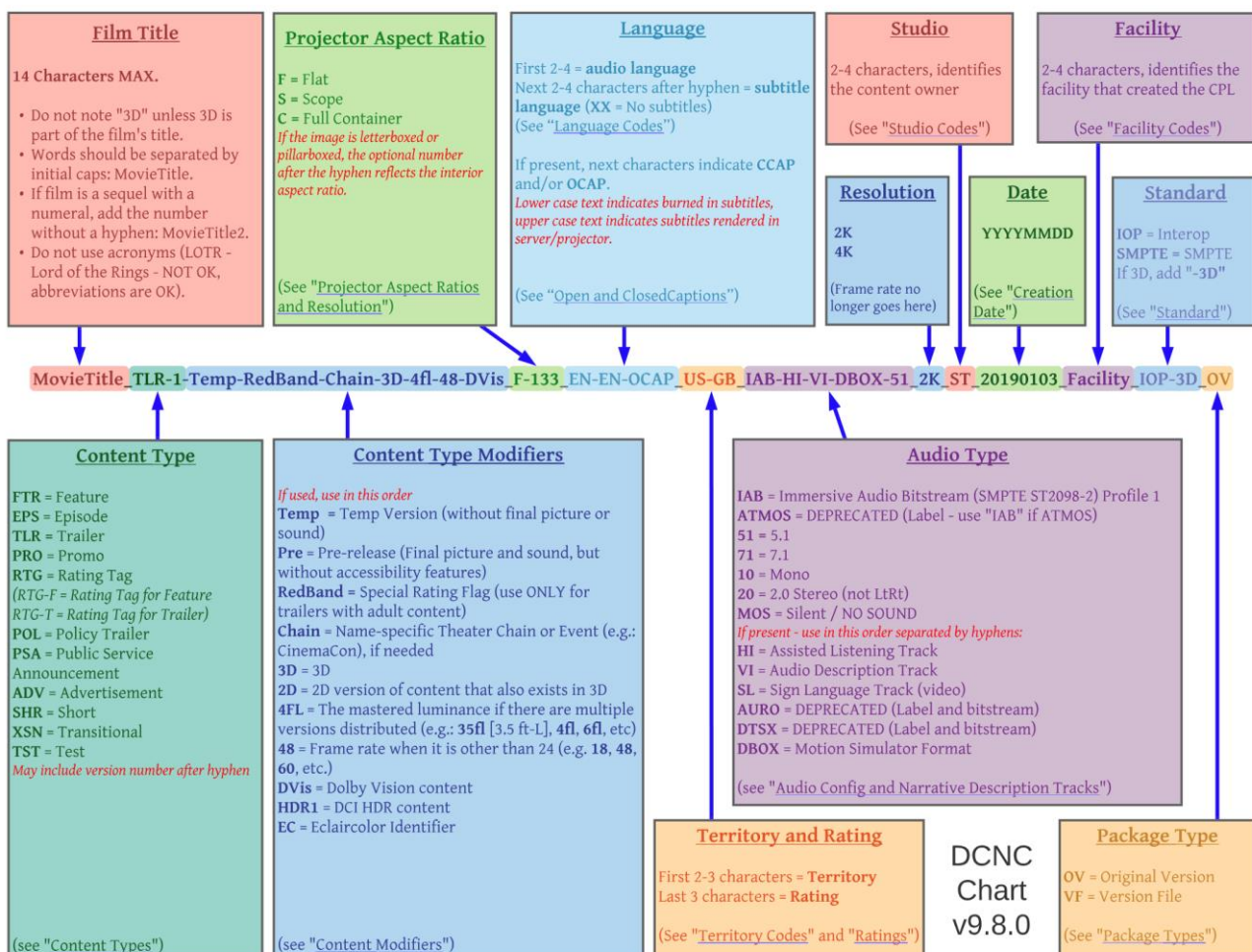


# Digital Cinema Naming Convention

The DCNC is a mandatory naming scheme for DCPs. For us the most important part is film/spot title, which cannot have more than 14 characters. The rest follows from the production needs and is usually filled in by us. Here are some examples:
